#### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

#### DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

RULE NO.: 33-102.101

RULE TITLE: Public Information and Inspection of Records

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To update Form DC1-201 regarding public records exemptions.

SUMMARY: To comply with legislative changes to § 119.071(2)(p), F.S., rulemaking is necessary to amend Form DC1-201 to include language stating that under certain circumstances a photograph, video recording, or audio recording that depicts or records the killing of a law enforcement officer who was acting in accordance with his or her official duties, or that depicts the killing of a victim of mass violence is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), F.S., and s. 24(a), Art. 1 of the State Constitution.

# SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

The Agency has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification based on the SERC or, if no SERC was required, the information expressly relied upon and described herein: The Department used an itemized checklist to conduct an economic analysis and determine if there would be any adverse impact or regulatory cost associated with this rule that exceeds the stated criteria. Upon review of the proposed rulemaking, the Department determined that the amendments will not exceed any one of the economic analysis criteria in a SERC as set forth in s. 120.541(2)(a), F.S.

Any person who wishes to provide information regarding a statement of estimated regulatory costs, or provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.
