PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of the proposed rule is to change the term mental retardation to

intellectual disability to comply with Chapter 2013-162.

SUMMARY: To change the term mental retardation to intellectual disability.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS: The agency has determined that this
