## THE PRELIMINARY TEXT OF THE PROPOSED RULE DEVELOPMENT IS:

33-401.401 Use of Tobacco Products.

(1) No change.

(2)(a) Pursuant to Section 944.115, F.S., use of any tobacco products shall be prohibited in all indoor areas of any building or office within a state correctional facility except for employee housing on department grounds and inmate maximum security (death row) housing areas. Only unlighted tobacco product use shall be permitted in death row housing <u>and community correctional centers</u>.

(b) No change.

(3) - (5) No change.

(6) Inmates, with the exception of those participating in a community release program under Rule 33-601.602,F.A.C., or as otherwise provided in subsection (7) of this rule, in administrative confinement, disciplinary

confinement, close management, and maximum management housing at all institutions shall not be allowed to possess any tobacco products or lighters.
