  - (a)(b) Sumter Correctional Institution;
  - (b)(e) Sumter Basic Training Unit;
  - (c)(d) Suwannee Correctional Institution;
  - (d)(e) Lowell Correctional Institution and Basic Training Unit;
  - (e)(f) Lake City Correctional Facility.
